CONSTRUCTION PROJECT


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin a safety improvement project in early 2026 along approximately 1.27 miles of roadway on U.S. 41 (State Road 45) from 63rd Avenue to 53rd Avenue in Manatee County. Improvements will include seven mid-block crosswalks with pedestrian beacons, signing and pavement markings, raised medians, curb and gutter, new ramps, sidewalk, signalization, lighting, intelligent transportation systems (ITS) and milling and resurfacing where the new pavement markings will be installed. The estimated project cost is \$4.6 million dollars.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Enhanced mid-block pedestrian crossings with pedestrian beacons and ramp improvements
- Raised medians
- Signage and pavement markings
- Sidewalks, curb and gutter
- Intelligent transportation systems
- Lighting and signalization

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins early 2026; estimated completion is late 2026
- Pedestrians and cyclists should follow all detours and signage throughout the project
- Motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures throughout the project
