# Project Purpose



This is a Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) project intended to extend the service life of the existing roadway. This project was identified because of deficient pavement conditions noted in the 2021 Pavement Condition Survey.



# Collaborative Discussions



On December 3, 2025, an initial public meeting was hosted by FDOT

More than 30 + attended and FDOT received 76 comments

To adapt to public comment, the engineering team revised the design plans



The project team then met with City Commissioners from December 12 – 19, 2025

Based on these collaborative discussions, the plans were revised further and FDOT continued to meet with City and County Commissioners in January

Today, FDOT is hosting this 2<sup>nd</sup> public meeting to share the revised plans.

# Project Overview



- Mill and resurface to extend the service life of roadway pavement
- Introduce curbed medians at select locations to improve safety,
- Modify curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Upgrade pedestrian signalization to improve pedestrian access and safety
- Replace / upgrade signing and pavement markings to comply with current standards and improve driver visibility
- Expand existing drainage system to alleviate ponding in the corridor



## Project Schedule

- **Construction Start Date: Fall 2026**
- **Anticipated Completion: Fall 2027**


- **Construction Cost: \$5.7 million**





# What To Expect During Construction




- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Temporary lane closures will take place during non-peak hours to reduce impact to the traveling public
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
- No traffic detours are necessary -  
Lane closures will be limited to one travel lane at a time



# What to Expect During Construction




Pedestrian detours will be used at locations where sidewalks are impacted by curb ramp and driveway reconstruction
