CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin work on May 27, 2021, to make improvements to SR 636 from US 17 to SR 64 in Hardee County. The project is approximately seven miles and the project limits are identified below on the project location map.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurface SR 636 from US 17 to SR 64
- Add signals at the intersection of SR 636 and US 17
- Improve drainage
- Install guardrail
- Install curb and gutter, signing and pavement markers
- Estimated construction cost is \$5 million

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins on May 27, 2021; estimated completion is spring 2022
- Daytime and nighttime lane closures will occur on SR 636 and US 17, as needed, during construction, weather permitting
- Portions of SR 636 will be closed during construction. Please follow detour signs and use caution in the work zones

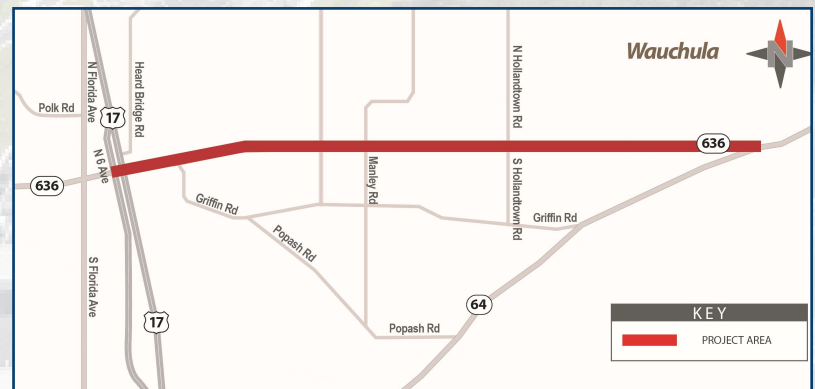
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Project Location Map
