



What is a PD&E?

A PD&E Study is an environmental and engineering process developed by the FDOT to determine social, economic, natural, physical, and environmental effects associated with a proposed transportation improvement project.

The process follows procedures set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and

federal and state laws and regulations. It requires the combined efforts of professional engineers, planners, and scientists who collect and analyze project-related information to develop the best solution for transportation needs. An important component of the process is public and agency coordination.
